## 5. Fire Fighting Measures

### 5.1. Extinguishing media

Suitable Extinguishing media: Product is non-flammable under normal conditions of storage, handling and use. In the case of combustion as a result of improper handling, storage or use preferably use polyvalent powder extinguishers (ABC powder), in

## 5.2. Special hazards arising from the substance or mixture
