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## 4. First Aid Measures

Measures in the event of

### Ingestion

 Inadvertent ingestion of larger amounts: do not induce vomiting. Rinse out mouth and drink about one glass of water. Where appropriate, consult Poison Control Centre or doctor. In the event of babies/infants always consult Poison Control Centre or doctor as a precautionary measure.

#### **Skin Contact**

- No action required

#### **Eye Contact**

– Inadvertent contact with eyes: rinse thoroughly with plenty of lukewarm water immediately; if irritation persists, consult an ophthalmologist as a precautionary measure.

#### **Inhalation**

- an improbable route of contact.

When consulting a doctor or a Poison Control Centre, always have packaging or label available.

## 5. Fire Fighting Measures

All common extinguishing agents are suitable.

## 6. Accidental Release Measures

In the event of spillage/leakage: mop up main volume with cloths; when larger amounts are involved, dispose of cloths and mopping up material by controlled disposal – risk of fire. Remove rest with plenty of water and common cleaning agent.

Packaging can be recycled after residual emptying and rinsing.

Filled, unused packages must be disposed of separately in accordance with the waste management directives of the local area.

# 7. Handling & Storage

Must be used in accordance with manufacturer's instructions. Observe any warnings on packaging. Store in a cool and dry place (room temperature). Reseal container after use.

Product is flammable. Do not expose to localised heat or sunlight. Do not store close to naked flames or sources of heat or use in their direct vicinity.

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# 8. Physical & Chemical Properties

The product is a chemically inert personal hygiene gel for hand cleansing.

# 9. Toxicological Information

The product has been thoroughly assessed as safe for its intended use in compliance with the requirements of Directive EC1223-2009.

# 10. Regulatory Information

The product is registered on the EU Cosmetics Portal in compliance with the requirements of Directive EC1223-2009.

## 11. Other Information
