4. First Aid Measures

Measures in the event of

Ingestion

 Inadvertent ingestion of larger amounts: do not induce vomiting. Rinse out mouth and drink about one glass of water. Where appropriate, consult Poison Control Centre or doctor.

Skin Contact

- No action required

Eye Contact

– Inadvertent contact with eyes: rinse thoroughly with plenty of lukewarm water immediately; if irritation persists, consult an ophthalmologist as a precautionary measure.

Inhalation

- an improbable route of contact.

When consulting a doctor or a Poison Control Centre, always have packaging or label available.

5. Fire Fighting Measures

All common extinguishing agents are suitable.

6. Accidental Release Measures

Filled, unused packages must be disposed of separately in accordance with the waste management directives of the local area.

7. Handling & Storage
