6. Accidental Release Measures

Avoid inhalation and contact with skin and eyes. Use suitable personal protective equipment.

Inform the fire brigade of large spills. Keep away from drains, surface and ground water, and soil. Spillages should be contained immediately and disposed of in accordance with local regulations.

Rapidly recover the product. To do so, wear suitable personal protective equipment. If possible collect the product for re-use or disposal. Do not allow the material to enter the drainage system.

7. Handling & Storage

Storage: Store in a cool, dry and ventilated area. Keep away from sources of ignition and naked flames.

Handling: Wear suitable personal protective equipment.

General Information: Give adequate ventilation to the premises where the product is stored and/or handled.

Hand protection: Avoid prolonged or repeated exposure. Use chemically resistant gloves as needed e.g. butyl rubber or nitrile rubber protective index 6.

Eye protection: Avoid contact. Wear safety glasses.

Respiratory: Use a suitable air-purifying or air-fed respirator if anticipated exposure levels indicate a possible hazard or exceed safe working limits.
